RESOLUTION NO. 91-M-35

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PERTAINING TO THE DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY BOARD; PROVIDING FOR TERMS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, by motion on July 22, 1975, created the Development Advisory Board consisting of nine (9) members serving one (1) year terms; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners amended the July 22, 1975 motion by motions on January 19, 1978, October 12, 1978 and November 30, 1987, increasing the number of members of the Development Advisory Board to thirteen (13); and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners now desires to provide for staggered terms of office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Terms. In order to achieve continuity through the staggering of terms of office which shall commence on July 1, 1991, six (6) members shall be appointed for a term of one (1) year and seven (7) members shall be appointed for a term of two (2) years. All subsequent appointments shall be staggered for two (2) year terms.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon the date of passage.
