RESOLUTION NO. 91-M-38

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO SURCHARGES ON
ELECTRICITY AND WATER FOR ORLANDO
UTILITIES COMMISSION CUSTOMERS LOCATED
WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF ORANGE
COUNTY.

PREMISES

1. On August 6, 1991, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, (the "Board"), adopted an ordinance levying a public service tax upon each purchase of electricity and water service at a rate of 10% of the payments received by the seller from the purchaser for the purchase of the service.

2. The Orlando Utilities Commission, ("OUC"), has been levying a surcharge of 10% on the purchase of electricity by its customers located in Orange County but outside the city limits of Orlando to equalize the rates paid by its customers.

3. OUC has been levying a surcharge of 25% on the purchase of water by its customers located in Orange County but outside the city limits of Orlando.

4. The Board desires to have the surcharge of 10% removed by OUC since the rates will now be equalized due to passage of the Orange County Public Services Tax ordinance.

5. The Board desires to have the surcharge of 25% on water service removed by OUC to the extent that the surcharge cannot be attributed to the extra cost incurred to provide service to those customers as supported by a "cost of service study."

ACCORDINGLY, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY.

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County respectfully requests the Orlando Utilities Commission to remove the surcharge of 10% from the purchase of electricity by its customers located within the unincorporated area of Orange County.

1 Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange
2 County respectfully requests the Orlando Utilities Commission
3 to remove the surcharge of 25% from the purchase of water by
4 its customers located within the unincorporated area of
5 Orange County to the extent that the surcharge cannot be
6 attributed to the extra cost incurred to provide service to
7 those customers as supported by a "cost of service study."

8 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect
9 immediately upon adoption.
