RESOLUTION NO. 92-M-01

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM SPEED  
LIMIT OF 25 MILES PER HOUR FOR THE RESI-  
DENTIAL DISTRICT KNOWN AS  
Laurel Hills-; Laurel Hills Unit 4-A; and Magellan Cove

WHEREAS, Section 316.189 and Section 316.183, Florida  
Statutes, as amended by Chapter 88-47, Laws of Florida,  
authorizes a county to set a maximum speed limit of 25 miles  
per hour for a residential district after an investigation  
determines that such a limit is reasonable; and

WHEREAS, Orange County has determined after an investi-  
gation that the maximum speed limit should be 25 miles per  
hour for the residential district known as \_\_\_\_\_  
Laurel Hills-1; Laurel Hills Unit 4-A, and Magellan Cove, including

all of Magellan Circle

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF  
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. The maximum speed limit shall be 25 miles per hour  
for all streets located within the residential district known  
as Laurel Hills-1; Laurel Hills Unit 4-A, and Magellan Cove, including

all of Megellan Circle

2. This Resolution shall become effective upon the  
date of its adoption.
