RESOLUTION NO. 92-M-16

A RESOLUTION CONVEYING SURPLUS COUNTY PROPERTY TO OAK RIDGE HIGH SCHOOL, ORANGE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS, A VALID GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA.

PREMISES

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County is in receipt of the application of Oak Ridge High School, Orange County Public Schools, for conveyance to it surplus paver blocks, which are currently County property, for a school remodeling project.

2. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County finds that said Oak Ridge High School, Orange County Public Schools, is a valid governmental agency of the State of Florida.

3. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County has been informed and hereby finds, that the County presently owns certain surplus property, namely:

Approximately 7500, 1' x 1' x 3 1/2" Cement Paver Blocks

which property is no longer of use to the County and no longer needed for County purposes.

4. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, by virtue of Section 125.38 Florida Statutes, is authorized to convey surplus County property no longer of use to or required by the County, to other governmental agencies of the State of Florida.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

1. Orange County shall and hereby does convey, by donation, the following property to Oak Ridge High School, Orange County Public Schools, namely:

Approximately 7500, 1' x 1' x 3 1/2" Cement Paver Blocks

2. Oak Ridge High School, Orange County Public Schools, will remove said property from its current site, at the Orange County Civic Center, at no cost or liability to Orange County.
