3 RESOLUTION OF THE ORANGE COUNTY BOARD OF
4 COUNTY COMMISSIONERS CONTINUING THE 1985
5 MANDATORY REFUSE PROGRAM, INCORPORATING
6 THE RECYCLING PROGRAM AND SETTING THE
7 CALENDAR YEAR 1993 SPECIAL ASSESSMENT AT
8 \$152.64.

9 WHEREAS, Section 32-160(k)(1), Orange County Code,
10 requires that all persons entitled to full refuse disposal
11 service shall be obligated to pay an annual amount for full
12 solid waste collection service; and

13 WHEREAS, Resolution 85-SW-06, as amended, requires that
14 all persons entitled to full refuse disposal service shall
15 also participate in the Orange County recycling program; and

16 WHEREAS, Section 32-160(k)(1), Orange County Code,
17 requires that the assessments necessary to subsidize solid
18 waste collection and recycling shall be set by resolution of
19 the Board of County Commissioners after public hearing with
20 public notice in the same manner as for county ordinances; and

21 WHEREAS, a copy of this Resolution has been published in
22 the Orlando Sentinel at least fifteen days (excluding Sundays
23 and legal holidays) prior to this September 3, 1992 hearing;
24 and

25 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners did on July
26 7, 1992 tentatively set the amount for garbage collection for
27 calendar year 1993 at \$152.64.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
2 COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

3 Section 1. That the 1993 installment of the 1985
4 mandatory garbage collection and recycling special assessment
5 program is hereby established at \$152.64. Said installment
6 is necessary to subsidize the cost of providing garbage
7 collection and recycling service to 129,000 residences in
8 1993 at an annual estimated cost of \$19,690,560.00.

9 Section 2. The mandatory refuse collection and
10 recycling charge shall continue to be imposed upon any parcel
11 of land within unincorporated Orange County on which is
12 located: a mobile home park not exceeding four (4) dwelling
13 units, mobile home subdivisions, single family residences,
14 multi-family residences not exceeding four (4) dwelling units
15 under one common roof. Each dwelling unit in a multi-family
16 residence shall constitute a separate benefit unit.

17 Section 3. The mandatory refuse and recycling special
18 assessment program shall continue through calendar year 1993
19 in all respects as described in Resolution 85-SW-06, as
20 amended, which created the Municipal Service Taxing Unit and
21 Orange County Ordinance 85-17, as amended, providing for the
22 procedures by which solid waste shall be collected and
23 disposed of in Orange County. The special assessments shall
24 be collected in the same manner as ad valorem taxes.

25 Section 4. The annual rate of compensation paid to the
26 franchisees providing collection services is hereby

established at the rate of \$140.28 per residential unit.

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
