RESOLUTION NO. 92-M-54

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE CHIEF CIRCUIT JUDGE OF THE NINTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT IN AND FOR ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS BEING RESPONSIBLE FOR RECRUITING, EMPLOYMENT AND TERMINATION OF JUDICIAL EMPLOYEES WHO ARE ON COUNTY PAYROLL AND EXEMPTING SAID EMPLOYEES FROM ORANGE COUNTY'S EMPLOYMENT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES.

WHEREAS, certain employees presently employed by the Courts in and for Orange County, Florida, are employed by Orange County; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide a more effective operation of said judicial system in regards to employment, management, and termination of such employees directly under the control of the Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit in and for Orange County, Florida, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

1. All County employees who are employed to work directly for the Judges in and for Orange County are hereby exempt from Orange County Personnel Policies and Procedures.

2. The Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit in and for Orange County, Florida is hereby designated the authority

2 termination of judicial employees who are provided to the
3 court system by Orange County.
