

RESOLUTION NO. 93-M-64

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE CHIEF CIRCUIT JUDGE OF THE NINTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT IN AND FOR ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS BEING RESPONSIBLE FOR RECRUITING, EMPLOYMENT AND TERMINATION OF CERTAIN JUDICIAL EMPLOYEES WHO ARE ON COUNTY PAYROLL AND EXEMPTING SAID EMPLOYEES FROM PROCEDURES AND POLICIES OF THE COUNTY PERTINENT TO COMPENSATION, RECRUITING, EMPLOYMENT, SUPERVISION, DISCIPLINE, GRIEVANCES, AND TERMINATION.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County enacted Resolution 92-M-54 on October 6, 1992, entitled: A Resolution Designating the Chief Circuit Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit in and for Orange County, Florida, as being Responsible for Recruiting, Employment and Termination of Certain Judicial Employees who are on County Payroll and Exempting said Employees from Procedures and Policies of the County Pertinent to Recruiting, Supervision, Discipline, and Termination; and

WHEREAS, questions as to the interpretation and application of said Resolution 92-M-54 have been raised by both the Court Administrator for the Ninth Judicial Circuit and the Orange County Department of Human Resources; and

WHEREAS, it is now the intent of the Board of County Commissioners to clarify the intent of the said Board as to the status of such judicial employees; and

WHEREAS, Section 43.28, Florida Statutes, mandates that Orange County shall provide judicial employees to the Circuit and County Court in and for Orange County, Florida to the

1 extent such employees are necessary to efficiently operate  
2 the judicial system within Orange County unless such  
3 employees are provided by the State of Florida; and

4 WHEREAS, the State of Florida is unable to provide  
5 sufficient employees to maintain the efficient operation of  
6 the judicial system within Orange County and, accordingly, it  
7 is incumbent upon Orange County to furnish such employees to  
8 the Circuit Court and County Court in and for Orange County  
9 to insure the proper operation of the judicial system within  
10 the County; and

11 WHEREAS, those parties assigned as operational employees  
12 of the Ninth Judicial Circuit are chosen by and under the  
13 direct supervision of Chief Judge of said Circuit and his  
14 designees and said employees are those in whom the Chief  
15 Judge reposes special trust and confidence, and such  
16 employees have been and continue to serve at the pleasure of  
17 the Chief Judge.

18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
19 ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

20 1. All employees of Orange County who are employed to  
21 work on detail for the Ninth Judicial Circuit are hereby  
22 declared to be exempt from the Orange County Personnel  
23 Policies and Procedures pertinent to recruiting, employment,  
24 compensation, supervision, discipline, grievances and  
25 termination of employment, such being the province of the

1 Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit, or his designee,  
2 and further, it is the declaration of this Board that such  
3 exemption is the clarification of a pre-existing employment  
4 policy of long standing.

5 2. All employees of Orange County who are employed to  
6 work on detail for the Ninth Judicial Circuit are hereby  
7 declared to be entitled to leave, retirement, and such other  
8 financial and/or economic "Fringe" benefits as are  
9 customarily extended to all other employees of Orange County,  
10 and, further, it is the declaration of this Board that such  
11 declaration as to pay and benefits is the clarification of a  
12 pre-existing employment policy of long standing.
