

RESOLUTION NO. 94-M-05

**A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THAT
THE BITHLO AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECT
IS CONSISTENT WITH LOCAL PLANS AND REGULATIONS**

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County adopted Resolution No. 90-M-12 promoting the establishment of a community land trust as a technique to meet affordable housing needs; and

WHEREAS, Orange County desires to acquire land in the area known as Bithlo for the development of affordable housing for low and moderate income residents; and

WHEREAS, Orange County desires to become an eligible sponsor of the Florida Department of Community Affairs' Community Contribution Tax For Incentive Program (CCTIP), and

WHEREAS, becoming recognized as an eligible sponsor of CCTIP will allow Orange County to receive land for the development of affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, Section 220.183 Florida Statutes requires a resolution from the local government unit in which the eligible sponsor is located certifying that the project is consistent with local plans and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the acquisition of land in the area known as Bithlo for the development of affordable housing for low and moderate income residents is consistent with local plans and regulations.

This Resolution shall become effective upon the date adopted.
