RESOLUTION NO. 94-M-23

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONTRIBUTION OF \$203,280 IN FUNDS ALLOCATED TO ORANGE COUNTY BY THE FLORIDA BOATING IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM; SUCH ALLOCATION TO BE MADE TO THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CERTAIN DOCK AND ADDITIONAL IMPROVEMENTS ON CLEAR LAKE, SUCH IMPROVEMENTS PROVIDING BENEFITS FOR THE RESIDENTS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, Orange County, Florida has received notice of proposed funds available from the State of Florida for the improvement of boating facilities, such funds being payable from the Florida Boating Improvement Program, and

WHEREAS, the City of Orlando intends to construct a certain dock and additional improvements to be located in George A. Barker, Jr. Park, servicing Clear Lake, which lake is within the territory of Orange County, and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid improvements, due to their geographical proximity to Orange County, may be used at least as much by residents of Orange County as by residents of the City of Orlando, and

WHEREAS, the City of Orlando has requested that Orange County earmark or allocate the sum of \$203,280 from its present allocation of Florida Boating Improvement Program funds to be used as a contribution to be made to the said City of Orlando for use by such authority in the funding of permanent capital improvements to be made as aforesaid by said authority to George A. Barker, Jr. Park, which site is

1 operated by the said authority, without charge, for the
2 convenience and enjoyment of residents of both the City of
3 Orlando and Orange County, and

4 WHEREAS, the scope and expense of such improvements are
5 exemplified in Exhibit "A", attached hereto, and

6 WHEREAS, it appears to the Board of County Commissioners
7 that it is in the best interest of the residents of Orange
8 County that the aforementioned requested contribution be made
9 from the allocation of Florida Boating Improvement Program
10 funds as such contribution will permit the construction of
11 permanent boating and associated improvements to the said
12 George A. Barker, Jr. Park and thus increase the boating
13 convenience and enjoyment of the residents of Orange County.

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
15 ORANGE COUNTY:

16 Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct
17 and incorporated into this resolution.

18 Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners does
19 hereby approve the application for and expenditure of funds
20 allocated to Orange County from the Florida Boating
21 Improvement Program funds in the sum of \$203,280 for the
22 purpose of contributing the same to the City of Orlando,
23 Florida so as to cause this authority to go forward with the
24 construction of permanent improvements for the improvement of

1 the boating and associated improvements to be operated and
2 maintained by said authority in George A. Barker, Jr. Park,
3 located on Lake Clear within Orange County. Said facilities
4 shall be maintained and said project shall be administered by
5 the City of Orlando, Florida.

6 Section 3. The Manager of the Orange County Parks and
7 Recreation Department is hereby authorized and empowered, in
8 the Name and under the authority of the Board of County
9 Commissioners, to do all acts and execute all documents
10 necessary and required to effectuate the intent of the Board
11 of County Commissioners as expressed by this resolution.

12 Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take
13 effect upon adoption.
