RESOLUTION NO. 94-M-31

**A RESOLUTION CONVEYING SURPLUS COUNTY EQUIPMENT TO HOLDEN HEIGHTS
CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA.**

PREMISE

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County is in receipt of an application from Holden Heights Chamber of Commerce for conveyance of miscellaneous patio tables and patio umbrellas, which is currently County property, for use at the Holden Heights Community Center.

2. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County finds that said Holden Heights Chamber of Commerce is a valid non-profit organization of the State of Florida.

3. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County has been informed and hereby finds, that the County presently owns certain surplus equipment, namely:

miscellaneous patio tables and patio umbrellas

which property is no longer of use to the County and no longer needed for County purposes.

4. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, by virtue of Section 125.38 Florida Statutes, is authorized to convey surplus County property no longer of use or required by the County to non-profit organizations of the State of Florida.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

1. Orange County shall and hereby does convey, by donation, the following property to Holden Heights Chamber of Commerce, namely:

miscellaneous patio tables and patio umbrellas

2. Holden Heights Chamber of Commerce will remove said property at no cost or liability to the County.
