RESOLUTION NO. 94-M-35

RESOLUTION TO CONVEY SURPLUS COUNTY EQUIPMENT TO TO AZALEA PARK LITTLE LEAGUE, INC., A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA

PREMISE

- 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County is in receipt of an application from Azalea Park Little League, Inc. for conveyance of a drinking fountain, which is currently County property, which will be installed at the little league park.
- 2. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County finds that Azalea Park Little League, Inc. is a valid non-profit in the State of Florida.
- 3. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County has been informed and hereby finds, that the County presently owns certain surplus equipment namely:

One (1) Drinking Fountain Cooling System

which said property is no longer of use to the County and no longer needed for County purposes.

- 4. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, by virtue of Section 125.38 Florida Statutes, is authorized to convey surplus County property no longer of use or required by the County to non-profit organizations which promote community interest and welfare at a price, nominal or otherwise, that the Board should affix.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ORANGE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

- 1. Orange County shall and hereby does convey, by donation, the following property to Azalea Park Little League, Inc., namely:

One (1) Drinking Fountain Cooling System

- 2. The transfer of said property to Azalea Park Little League, Inc. shall result in no cost or liability to the County.
