A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY,
FLORIDA URGING CONTINUED APPROPRIATION OF FUNDING FOR THE SURFACE
WATER IMPROVEMENT AND MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Orange County citizens have advanced environmental preservation and restoration efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Surface Water and Improvement Management Program (SWIM) is designed to improve Florida waters, including those in Orange County; and

WHEREAS, the benefits of SWIM have a direct, positive impact on the citizens of Orange County; and

WHEREAS, the SWIM program as operated by the St. Johns River Water Management District is critical to the restoration of Lake Apopka in Orange County;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the Orange County Board of County Commissioners hereby urges the Legislature of the State of Florida to support in any appropriate way the continued funding of the SWIM program.
