RESOLUTION NO. 95-M-43

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ORANGE COUNTY STAFF TO ENTER INTO A URBAN AND COMMUNITY FORESTRY GRANT MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND CONSUMER SERVICES, DIVISION OF FORESTRY.

WHEREAS, the Orange County Chairman and Board of County Commissioners desire that Orange County beautify and improve various rights-of-way and other public areas within Orange County by landscaping; and

WHEREAS, the OrangeScape Committee has ranked beautification projects, and seeks grant funds to beautify a portion of Orange Avenue from Sand Lake Road to Tradeport Drive through the community of Taft; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Taft have expressed interest in learning urban forestry principles, which will be taught to them as they plant trees at the Taft Community Center located on Orange Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Orange County Chairman and Board of County Commissioners authorize staff to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement between Orange County and the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services requires that the grant applicant adopt a Resolution as follows, prior to submission of the grant application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

That staff is authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement between Orange County and the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services and accept grant funds for beautification of Orange Avenue.
