RESOLUTION NO. 95-M-58

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 25 MILES PER HOUR FOR THE RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT KNOWN AS South Pine Run Unit 1 and South Pine Run Unit 2.

WHEREAS, Section 316.189 and Section 316.183, Florida Statutes, as amended by Chapter 88-47, Laws of Florida, authorizes a county to set a maximum speed limit of 25 miles per hour for a residential district after an investigation determines that such a limit is reasonable; and

WHEREAS, Orange County has determined after an investigation that the maximum speed limit should be 25 miles per hour for the residential district known as South Pine Run Unit 1 and South Pine Run Unit 2.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. The maximum speed limit shall be 25 miles per hour for all streets located within the residential district known as South Pine Run Unit 1 and South Pine Run Unit 2.

2. This Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its adoption.
