RESOLUTION NO. 95- M-67

A RESOLUTION OF THE ORANGE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZING THE CABLE TELEVISION FRANCHISE TRANSFER FROM TELESAT CABLEVISION, INC. TO TELESAT ACQUISITION LIMITED PARTNERSHIP.

WHEREAS, Telesat Cablevision, Inc., currently holds a nonexclusive franchise to engage in the business of cable television within Orange County, Florida;

WHEREAS, Telesat Cablevision, Inc., has requested that its franchise be transferred to Telesat Acquisition Limited Partnership;

WHEREAS, Telesat Acquisition Limited Partnership has the technical ability, financial capability, legal qualification and general character qualifications to operate a cable television system and no reason has been shown why a transfer of franchise should not be granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. That the cable television franchise granted to Telesat Cablevision, Inc., on June 23, 1986 is hereby approved to be transferred to Telesat Acquisition Limited Partnership, to have and to hold so long as Telesat Acquisition Limited Partnership complies with all provisions of the franchise for the remaining term of the franchise.

2. That prior to the transfer becoming effective, Telesat Acquisition Limited Partnership will become a signatory to the franchise license.

3. That Telesat Acquisition Limited Partnership will operate its franchise under the name of Adelpia Cable Communications.

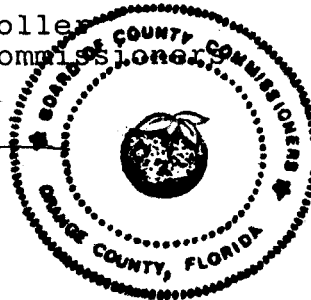
