RESOLUTION NO. 95-M-71

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING DESIGNATED TOW-AWAY ZONE(S) IN UNINCORPORATED ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. Pursuant to Orange County Code, Chapter 35, Traffic, Article II, Administration and Enforcement, the County Traffic Engineer has recommended to the Board of County Commissioners that a designated tow-away zone be established at the following location(s):

On the west side of Dixie Belle Drive beginning from 100 feet south of the south right-of-way line of Pershing Avenue and extending 750 feet north.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners hereby adopts the County Traffic Engineer's recommendation and establishes the location(s) described in Section I above as a designated tow-away zones(s).

Section 3. The designated tow-away zone(s) herein established shall be marked with signs and administered and enforced pursuant to Orange County Code, Chapter 35, Article II.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
