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RESOLUTION NO. 95-M-79

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RESOLUTION AMENDING THE ORANGE COUNTY  
SCHEDULE OF FEES AS TO FEE CHARGED BY THE  
ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT FOR INSPECTIONS  
CONDUCTED AT TIMES OTHER THAN NORMAL WORKING  
HOURS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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11 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has authority  
by law to enact and, from time to time, amend fees charged by  
13 the various departments of the Orange County Government for  
various services rendered to the public; and

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17 WHEREAS, Orange County can legally charge a fee for such  
services that capture the reasonable cost associated with  
administrative, personal services, operating, capital, and  
19 overhead to provide that service; and

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23 WHEREAS, the Engineering Department of the Public Works  
Division has conducted a study to determine reasonable costs  
incurred in the conduct of inspections at times other than  
normal County working hours, and the Department has  
25 determined as a result of such study that amount presently  
assessed for said fee should be modified; and

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29 WHEREAS, the Office of Management & Budget has reviewed  
and approved the fee revision provided to it by the Public  
Works Division; and

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33 WHEREAS, the Office of Management & Budget recommends  
that the fee modification set forth hereinafter be approved  
by the Board of County Commissioners as to services rendered  
35 or for which application is made on and after August 1, 1995,  
or as soon thereafter as this Resolution is enacted.

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
39 ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby  
41 amends the fee schedule for County Government departments as  
shown in the fee schedule attached hereto, marked Exhibit  
43 "A", as follows:

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Section 2. All other Resolutions or parts of

which can be given effect without the invalid provision or

63 application and to this end the provisions of this Resolution

are declared severable.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take

65 effect immediately upon its adoption.

ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT, continued

Septic Tank Variance

Application Routing Fee.....	\$	17.00
Application Processing Fee.....	\$	50.00

Refer to the Environmental Protection and Health sections of this directory for additional septic tank variance permit issuance fees.

Refunds

Basic, minimum, processing, application, and reinspection fees are non-refundable.

Permit Transfer Fee.....	\$	52.00
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Late Charges (Applicable in all cases where construction commences without a valid Orange County Engineering Department permit).

The late fee shall be equal to the permit fee, with a minimum fee of \$250.00 and a maximum of \$1,000.00.

Late charge fees will not apply to emergency work provided a permit is applied for within two working days following the commencement of emergency work and the appropriate fee is paid.

Inspection fee other than normal working hours

Rate per hour, or fraction thereof.....	\$	32.00
4 hour minimum.....		128.00

Requests for special after-hours (other than normal working hours, weekend or holiday) inspections must be submitted in writing by the developer/contractor to the Engineering Department forty-eight hours in advance of the requested inspection. The minimum number of hours that will be approved is four hours. No inspection(s) will be performed until the assessed fee has been paid.

Overtime inspection required as continuation of work-in-progress at the end of a normal working day shall be paid for at the hourly rate for the actual number of hours (or any fraction thereof) worked. No project will be certified as complete until all assessed fees have been paid.
