RESOLUTION NO. 96-M-03

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ORANGE COUNTY STAFF TO ENTER INTO A HIGHWAY LANDSCAPING MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR BEAUTIFICATION OF ALAFAYA TRAIL FROM UNIVERSITY BOULEVARD TO STATE ROAD 50.

WHEREAS, many roadside areas and median strips abutting Department of Transportation rights-of-way must be maintained and attractively landscaped; and

WHEREAS, the Orange County Chairman and Board of County Commissioners desire that Orange County beautify and improve various rights-of-way within Orange County by landscaping; and

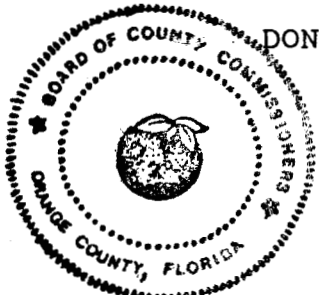
WHEREAS, the OrangeScape Committee has ranked beautification projects, and seeks grant funds to beautify Alafaya Trail from University Boulevard to State Road 50; and

WHEREAS, the Orange County Chairman and Board of County Commissioners authorize staff to enter into a Highway Landscaping Maintenance Agreement between Orange County and the Florida Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation requires that the grant applicant adopt a Resolution as follows, prior to submission of the grant application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

That staff is authorized to enter into a Highway Landscaping Maintenance Agreement between Orange County and the State of Florida Department of Transportation and accept grant funds for beautification of Alafaya Trail from University Boulevard to State Road 50.
