AUTHORIZING APPLICATION BY ORANGE COUNTY TO  
THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES  
FOR FLORIDA BOATING IMPROVEMENT FUNDS FOR  
THE ACQUISITION OF THE LAKE SHEEN PARCELS AS  
THE SITE OF A NEW COUNTY BOATING RAMP.

11 WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature has created a Motorboat  
Revolving Trust Fund funded from boat license fees collected  
13 within the several counties of Florida; and

15 WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Legislature to return a  
portion of boat license fees to counties from which such fees  
17 were collected, to be used for the purposes of acquiring,  
developing and improving property for public boat launching  
19 facilities and dredging and other boating facility  
improvement activities; and

23 WHEREAS, the Orange County Parks and Recreation  
Department has requested that Orange County make application  
to the Florida Department of Natural Resources Boating  
25 Improvement Program for funds for the purchase of property on  
Lake Sheen known as the "Lake Sheen Boat Ramp Facility"  
27 (hereinafter, the "Project") which has been purchased by  
Orange County for \$490,861.00; and

31 WHEREAS, it is within the intent of the Legislature that  
the funds for such acquisitions will come from the said  
Motorboat Revolving Trust Fund and not from the Orange County  
33 General Fund; and

35 WHEREAS, the aforementioned Project enhances recreational  
boating on the Butler Chain of Lakes and thereby is of great  
37 benefit to the residents of and visitors to Central Florida.

39 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
ORANGE COUNTY:

41 The Manager of the Orange County Parks and Recreation  
Department is hereby designated the Orange County liaison  
43 agent to the Florida Boating Improvement Program and, as  
such, said the Manager is hereby authorized to execute and

45 submit the attached application for funding for the "Lake  
Sheen Boat Ramp Facility" and submit the same on behalf of  
47 Orange County to the Florida Department of Natural Resources.
