A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE ORANGE COUNTY  
JUVENILE COURTHOUSE AS THE "THOMAS S. KIRK  
JUVENILE JUSTICE CENTER" IN TRIBUTE TO THE  
HONORABLE THOMAS S. KIRK.

WHEREAS, the Honorable Thomas S. Kirk, now deceased, devoted fourteen years of his legal career to juvenile justice by sitting with great distinction and wisdom upon the bench of the Juvenile Division of the Circuit Court of Orange County, and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Thomas S. Kirk departed this life April 10, 1996, leaving as part of his judicial legacy the present Orange County Juvenile Courthouse, which edifice was constructed in large part due to his planning and continued efforts to create said edifice; and

WHEREAS, both Orange County bench and bar and Orange County's citizenry have urged the Board of County Commissioners to create a suitable memorial to honor the memory of the said Thomas S. Kirk; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to designate the Orange County Juvenile Courthouse in such fashion that it shall stand as a permanent and fitting tribute to the said Thomas S. Kirk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. The Orange County Juvenile Courthouse located at 2000 E. Michigan Avenue, Orlando, Florida, hereby is and shall be designated as the  
  
"THOMAS S. KIRK JUVENILE JUSTICE CENTER"
2. The appropriate officers and employees of Orange County shall insure such designation becomes permanently memorialized by erection and maintenance of appropriate signage.
3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately and a certified copy hereof shall be delivered to the family of said Thomas S. Kirk by the County Chairman.
