RESOLUTION NO. 97-M-05

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ORANGE COUNTY STAFF TO ENTER INTO AN MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR A HIGHWAY BEAUTIFICATION GRANT FOR GOLDENROD ROAD FROM ALOMA AVENUE TO LAKE UNDERHILL ROAD.

WHEREAS, many roadside areas and median strips abutting Department of Transportation rights-of-way must be maintained and attractively landscaped; and

WHEREAS, the Orange County Chairman and Board of County Commissioners desire that Orange County beautify and improve various rights-of-way within Orange County by landscaping; and

WHEREAS, the OrangeScape Committee has ranked beautification projects, seeks grant funds from the Florida Department of Transportation to beautify Goldenrod Road from Aloma Avenue to Lake Underhill Road; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation requires that Orange County adopt a Resolution as follows, prior to submission of the grant application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

That Orange County staff is authorized to enter into a Highway Beautification Grant memorandum of agreement with the State of Florida Department of Transportation for beautification of Goldenrod Road from Aloma Avenue to Lake Underhill Road.
