RESOLUTION NO. 97-M-17

A RESOLUTION CANCELING CURRENT AD VALOREM TAXES ASSESSED AGAINST TAX PARCELS AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County is empowered by Section 196.28, Florida Statutes, to act by resolution to cancel delinquent and current real estate tax assessments and delinquent tax assessments for which tax certificates have not as yet been sold against tax parcels within the County when such parcels are acquired by the County and dedicated to public use; and

Whereas, it appears to the Board of County Commissioners that tax parcel set forth below was acquired for the betterment of the community and use for public purpose by the County.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA;

Section 1. Under authority of Section 196.28, Florida Statutes, all current real estate tax assessments and delinquent tax assessments, for which tax certificates have not as yet been sold, assessed against the tax parcel set forth hereinbelow are cancelled and discharged, effective immediately :

Tax Parcel: 32-22-29-4604-01-080

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be certified by the Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners to the Tax Collector of Orange County.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
