THE APPLICATION OF RESTORE ORLANDO, INC. AS A DESIGNATED PROJECT OF THE ENTERPRISE ZONE COMMUNITY CONTRIBUTION TAX CREDIT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Orange County established the Enterprise Zone Program to reverse conditions of poverty, unemployment and general distress in the targeted areas of South Apopka, Eatonville and Parramore-Heritage, South Orange Blossom Trail and the Southwest Communities of Orlando; and

WHEREAS, the Enterprise Zone Community Contribution Tax Credit Program allows non-profit organizations to receive donations from businesses in exchange for a fifty percent corporate tax credit; and

WHEREAS, Restore Orlando, Inc. seeks to become designated as an approved project under the Community Contribution Tax Credit Program; and

WHEREAS, Restore Orlando, Inc. provides services in the Enterprise Zone communities within Orlando; and

WHEREAS, Section 220.183(5)(a) Florida Statutes requires any proposed project to provide a resolution of support from the local government indicating the project's consistency with local plans and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Restore Orlando, Inc. project was found to be consistent with the Orange County Comprehensive Policy Plan upon staff review.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board supports the application of Restore Orlando, Inc. to become an approved project under the Enterprise Zone Community Contribution Tax Credit Program

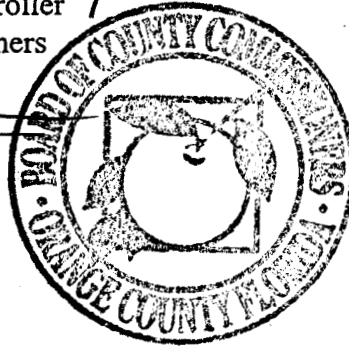
