WHEREAS, the Florida Main Street Program ("Program") has been created to assist communities in the State of Florida in developing public-private efforts to revitalize their "Main Street" areas; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State of the State of Florida will be selecting a number of Florida communities to participate in the Program in the upcoming year; and

WHEREAS, the community of Goldenrod has formed a non-profit corporation known as the Historic Village at Goldenrod, Inc. which intends to file an application to participate in the Program.

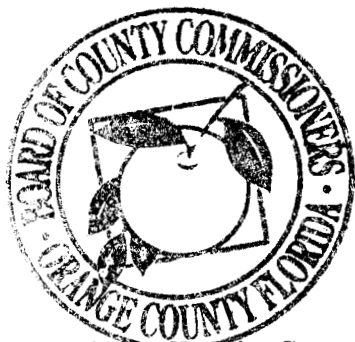
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

**Section 1.** The Board hereby endorses the decision by the Historic Village at Goldenrod, Inc. to file an application on behalf of the community of Goldenrod to participate in the Florida Main Street Program with the specific goal of revitalizing the community of Goldenrod within the context of the Main Street Approach™.



**Section 3.** This Resolution shall become effective on the date of its adoption.


