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**TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS  
ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA**

ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of June 2016 were \$19,764,900. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Haynie indicated that June 2016 collections were nearly 3% higher than June 2015. "Once again, I want to remind everyone that the TDT does not always grow at record-setting levels. June's collections are more than \$6 million ahead of last year's, and that is good news, even though the percentage month-to-month growth was a little behind what we have gotten used to. Nevertheless, for the fiscal year 2016, the TDT is up more than 6 percent and this remains a remarkably strong and resilient revenue for the county and the community," stated Haynie.
