TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of May 2016 were \$18,557,400. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Haynie indicated that May 2016 collections were 4% higher than May 2015. "These strong numbers for May should be a sign that there is a good summer tourist season ahead. As the County continues to pay down its current obligations, we can begin long range planning for the future," stated Haynie.
