**TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS  
ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA**

ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of November 2013 were \$15,454,400. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Haynie noted that November 2013 collections were nearly 4% higher than November 2012. "Our tourist development tax collections are continuing their strong showing," Haynie stated.
