**TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS
ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA**

ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of November 2015 were \$18,812,700. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Haynie indicated that November 2015 collections were nearly 8% higher than November 2014. "The resort tax continues to show solid gains," stated Haynie.
