**TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS
ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA**

ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of October 2013 were \$15,120,200. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Haynie noted that October 2013 collections were nearly 3% higher than October 2012. "It's good to see that we are continuing the positive trend," Haynie stated.
