TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX COLLECTIONS ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of June 2015 were \$19,088,300. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and

motels.

Comptroller Haynie indicated that June 2015 collections were 6% higher than June 2014. "While the June year over year increase is not as robust as we have seen during the first seven months of our fiscal year, cumulative collections are more than 11% ahead of last year," stated Haynie.
