ORLANDO, FLORIDA -- County Comptroller Martha Haynie announced today that tourist tax collections (resort tax) received by the County for the hotel collection month of October 2015 were \$18,957,900. Tourist taxes are charged on short-term rentals, mostly hotels and motels.

Comptroller Haynie indicated that October 2015 collections were 8% higher than October 2014. "This is a very nice way to start out the new fiscal year," stated Haynie.
