SUBJ: LoJack Theft Recovery Units – Purchase Order M68503 - Discussion Item

The LoJack System technology allows for stolen vehicles to be located and recovered. The LoJack recovery unit is a small unmarked radio frequency transmitter designed exclusively for construction equipment and vehicles. LoJack is a self-powered unit that provides an efficient and effective way of recovering stolen vehicles. LoJack has a high percentage recovery rate due to it being integrated with law enforcement. LoJack requires no monthly maintenance service fees and out performs GPS tracking units.

Orange County Public Works Department staff has reviewed this technology, and solicited competitive bids for similar technology. Staff would like to discuss with the Board of County Commissioners, the recommendation to award a “sole source” contract to LoJack for their vehicle fleet.

Action Requested: Board approval of Purchase Order M68503, Purchase of LoJack units in the award amount of \$163,800.
