Management for the South Water Reclamation Facility

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y15-1028-PD, Biosolids Management for the South Water Reclamation Facility, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, H&H Liquid Sludge Disposal, Inc., in the estimated annual contract award amount of \$1,185,288. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to exercise option years one and two.

PROCUREMENT:

This contract provides for all labor, processes, materials and equipment necessary for the removal, transport and disposal of biosolids produced at the South Water Reclamation Facility. This facility is located in District 6.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 4420 038 1351 3197.

APPROVALS:

The Business Development Division and the Water Reclamation Division concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Four bids were received and evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility and price. H&H Liquid Sludge Disposal, Inc. is the lowest responsive responsible bidder. The bid is considered reasonable based on comparison with the current County contract for the same service. Therefore, award is recommended to H&H Liquid Sludge Disposal, Inc.
