SUBJECT: Discussion Agenda Item for October 20, 2015
Sheriff Jerry Demings' Presentation Request

On October 20, 2015 Sheriff Jerry Demings will be making a presentation to the Board requesting \$150,000 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund to pay for a private security law enforcement pilot program. The pilot program would fund a private security company to provide enhanced services in the neighborhoods of Holden Heights and Azalea Park. The services may include activities such as checking abandoned properties, residential security surveys, victim/citizen contacts, checks of elderly and high crime hotspots.

Funding from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund is allowable for this program.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval to use \$150,000 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund to pay for a private security law enforcement pilot program.

SUBJECT: Trust Fund Request – Public/Private Security Partnership

Please develop a trust fund request for \$150,000 to fund a private security/law enforcement pilot program.

The pilot program would consist of a private security company contracted with the Orange County Sheriff's Office to provide enhanced services in the neighborhoods of Holden Heights and Azalea Park for a minimum of a 90 day period. The enhanced services may include activities such as checking abandoned or vacant properties, residential security surveys, victim/citizen contacts, identifying code enforcement violations that contribute to blight, checks on the elderly and high visibility in crime hotspots.

The funds would be used to contract with the private security company, to fund interns from UCF who will conduct surveys and collect data and for miscellaneous administrative expenses, e.g. printing and postage.
