The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$29,000 from the FY 2016 Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the following purposes:

Contributions:

2016 Annual NAMI Walks Greater Orlando – \$1,500. The National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) is the nation's largest grassroots mental health organization dedicated to building better lives for the millions of Americans affected by mental illness. NAMI advocates for access to services, treatment, supports and research, and is dedicated in its commitment to raise awareness and build a community for hope for all of those in need. NAMI Greater Orlando is closely involved in our Crisis Intervention Team training. They offer a valuable support to the program by providing instruction to law enforcement officers on how to deal with mentally ill individuals.

Nuevo Sendero, Inc. - \$5,000. This organization is dedicated to promoting and maintaining a high level of public awareness regarding the impact of domestic violence, sexual abuse, and family relationships. The agency also wants to ensure that the community is educated on the impact of domestic violence and sexual abuse on the family unit, particularly youths.

Boys & Girls Clubs of Central Florida - \$15,000. This organization provides a compelling alternative to youth crime, gang membership, drugs, and other negative influences that affect our youth today by reaching children at an early age and providing positive activities and encouragement.

Boy Scouts of America, Central Florida Council – \$7,500. The Boy Scouts of America’s mission is to provide at-risk youth who desperately need guidance and role models with a quality scouting program that will enable them to recognize and reach their full potential.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff’s Office to spend \$29,000 from the FY 2016 Law Enforcement Trust Fund to provide eligible contributions to 2016 Annual NAMIWalks Greater Orlando (\$1,500); Nuevo Sendero, Inc. (\$5,000); Boys & Girls Clubs of Central Florida (\$15,000); and Boy Scouts of America, Central Florida Council (\$7,500).

PLEASE NOTE: The Board voted to establish spending limits of 20% for this fund for contributions. At this point in the fiscal year, contributions represent 6% of the total expenditures; however, the restriction applies to total expenditures for the year, at year-end. The Sheriff’s Office has stated that they monitor their expenditures, and that they will not exceed the 20% total for contributions.
