SUBJ: **Reduce the Posted Speed Limit on Bancroft Boulevard from 50 Miles Per Hour to 45 Miles Per Hour.**

A concerned citizen has requested the County to review the posted speed limit on Bancroft Boulevard in the Wedgefield Community. The current posted speed limit is 50 miles per hour.

The new Wedgefield K-8 School will open in August 2016. A reduced posted speed limit of 45 mph is recommended on Bancroft Boulevard from Nettleton Street to Paddock Street as part of the traffic control for the new school. Other improvements include construction of a left turn lane on southbound Bancroft Blvd at Ortega Street to accommodate school busses and installation of a school crossing with a 20 mph flasher on Bancroft Blvd at Nettleton Street.

Staff recommends that the Board approve to reduce the posted speed limit from 50 mph to 45 mph on Bancroft Boulevard from Nettleton Street to Paddock Street.

**Action Requested: Approval to reduce posted speed limit on Bancroft Boulevard from Nettleton Street to Paddock Street from 50 mph to 45 mph. District 5.**

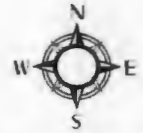
# Bancroft Boulevard Consent Agenda District Map
