As of 2018, Florida (<http://worldpopulationreview.com/us-counties/fl/miami-dade-county-population/>) Miami (/us-cities/miami-population/)-Dade County is the most populous county in the Sunshine State (<http://worldpopulationreview.com/us-counties/fl/broward-county-population/>), with 2,751,796 residents, representing a population growth of 10.2% since the last census. Miami-Dade is followed by Broward County (<http://worldpopulationreview.com/us-counties/fl/palm-beach-county-population/>) (1,935,878), Palm Beach County (<http://worldpopulationreview.com/us-counties/fl/hillsborough-county-population/>) (1,471,150), Hillsborough County (<http://worldpopulationreview.com/us-counties/fl/orange-county-population/>) (1,381,627), and Orange County (<https://www.census.gov/quickfacts/fact/table/orangecountyflorida,palmbeachcountyflorida,browardcountyflorida,miamidadecountyflorida/PST045217>) (1,323,598) as the only other counties in the state with populations in excess of one million. Of these, Orange County has seen the highest population growth at an impressive 17.7%.

Florida Counties with Fewer Residents

The least populous Floridian counties

(<http://worldpopulationreview.com/us-counties/fl/liberty-county-population/>) Liberty County (<http://worldpopulationreview.com/us-counties/fl/lafayette-county-population/>) Lafayette (/us-cities/lafayette-population/) County, with its population of 8,451. Both of these counties have seen their populations decline in recent years, with reductions of 1.5% and 4.7%, respectively. However, other counties with small populations, such as Franklin County (<http://worldpopulationreview.com/us-counties/fl/franklin-county-population/>) (11,727) and Glades County (<http://worldpopulationreview.com/us-counties/fl/glades-county-population/>) (13,754), have had population increases (1.5% for Franklin County and 6.8% for Glades County).

Florida Counties with Rapid Growth

Sumter County (<http://worldpopulationreview.com/us-counties/fl/osceola-county-population/>) boasts the highest growth rate in the state, with a substantial increase of 34% according to statistics for 2018, taking its total population to 125,165. Osceola County (<http://worldpopulationreview.com/us-counties/fl/st-johns-county-population/>) also show impressive population growth, with increases of 31.1% and 28.3%, respectively. Bradford (/world-cities/bradford-population/) County, with its 2010 population of 28,520, has the biggest reduction in numbers, its population fell to 27,773, representing a negative growth of -5.2% in the last few years.
